Tom has been banding birds at our Scheele Preserve on Kelleys Island for 25 years— and just celebrated his 95,000<sup>th</sup> bird banding! Tom is a gifted biologist, and his work in bird conservation has led to significant properties being preserved by the Museum and partner organizations. Another thank you to his wife, Paula, who is with him every scientific step of the way!

LIFE FLIGHT – METROHEALTH is officially our new Life Flight provider (taking over from St. Vincent's). Legislation was passed on October 21 and took effect 30 days later. The EMS Coordinator, Russell Maust, who is also a certified paramedic, will organize and lead the EMS services for the Village. Russell and his wife Chrissy moved to Kelleys Island in 2004 from Canton, Ohio. Russell graduated from Stark State University with a degree in Fire Sciences. Russell earned his Paramedic Certification in 2003, and in 2004, he was hired as a full time Medic for Sandusky County EMS. Over the past sixteen years, he served as a paramedic for both Sandusky County and in a volunteer capacity on Kelleys Island. We welcome Russell into his new role!

At 10 a.m., Pat Hayes will be doing a BIRD WALK and NATURE HIKE. **Adopt a bird for \$5 to personally support the KI Audubon Club.** 



**5 & 10K Run/Walk** - **Sunday, June 6, 2021:** 8 a.m. - 3 p.m. Join the 38th Annual Kelleys Island 5 & 10K Run/Walk. Runners will enjoy a scenic route, especially along the lakefront. Numerous water stations will be provided. Walkers and strollers are welcome. A portion of the proceeds will be

donated to Back to the Wild, a local wildlife restoration and nature education center, with the remainder going to support the Kelleys Island Chamber of Commerce. <u>Registration</u> is at 8 a.m. downtown at Memorial Park. The race starts at 10:45 a.m. from the same spot. A discounted rate of \$20 will be available to those who pre-register online at least one week before the race. Day-of registration will cost \$25. Awards will be distributed to men's and women's Overall, and the first three places in each male and female age group.

## Nature Camp - Monday, July 5 - 9, 2021

The Nature Camp, located at the Kelleys Island Field Station and partnered with the Kelleys Island State Park and the KI Audubon Club, was started in 2003 on South Bass and Middle Bass Islands. Each year a different theme is designed to encourage the natural curiosity of youth's ages 4-11 by engaging them in outdoor fun and educational activities. Nature Camp has a small fee for island residents to supplement the cost of supplies, and a separate cost for nonresidents. All campers will be provided refillable water bottles, neck wallets/ name tags, 2021 camp themed t-shirts, ODNR Field Guides, and other crafts and projects. The older campers (9-11) will go kayaking and go on an overnight camping trip.

## **KELLEYS ISLAND LANDOWNERS ASSOCIATION - Contributions**

KILA relies on several sources of revenue to support our projects and initiatives to improve and enhance Kelleys Island. These include membership dues, fund raising activities, and donations. In addition to supporting these projects, your donation to KILA, a 501.c.3 charitable organization, has some tax advantages per IRS regulations.

- 1. Your donation may be deductible when you itemize expenses.
- 2. But, if you claim the standard deduction, you may still claim a deduction, **in addition** to the standard deduction, of up to \$300. For 2020, the \$300 maximum is per "tax unit," which means you can only deduct \$300, no matter whether you're filing a joint return or a single return. But for the 2021 tax year, those filing jointly can get a maximum deduction of \$600.
- 3. You may make a Qualified Charitable Contribution (QCD) **directly** from your IRA to KILA. This direct donation does not count as ordinary income to you as a distribution from your retirement plan usually would. This QCD will count towards your required minimum distribution (RMD) for those of you older than 70.5. However, the limit of the contribution (QCD) is \$100,000 per person.

Please consult with your tax advisor to be sure you understand the tax issues with these donations.
