KILA relies on membership dues, fund raising activities, and donations to support projects and initiatives to improve and enhance Kelleys Island. In addition to supporting projects like these, a donation to KILA, a 501.c.3 charitable organization, has some tax advantages per IRS regulations.

- 1. Your donation may be deductible when you itemize expenses.
- 2. You may make a Qualified Charitable Contribution (QCD) **directly** from your IRA to KILA. This direct donation does not count as ordinary income to you as a distribution from your retirement plan usually would. This QCD will count towards your required minimum distribution (RMD) for those of you older than 70.5. However, the limit of the contribution (QCD) is \$100,000 per person.

Please consult with your tax advisor to be sure you understand the tax issues with these donations.
